

Small Serger Cover

Size 16 in wide x 14 in high x 11 deep

Designed to fit the Babylock Imagine, Enlighten and other smaller machines. Note:
Telescopic thread arm is lowered to fit these Covers

Pattern includes the following techniques, working with wire, flatlock weaving, prairie points, no turn casing and cording. The patchwork pocket section on the back of cover holds the `Threading Guide`, the two side pockets hold flex and foot pedal.

Access to a number of videos to help you with the techniques.



I fussy cut the Front Lower Panel to get the rabbit centered in this panel. I also did the same with the Top Panel but it was a waste of time as the Diagonal sash decoration completely obscures the rabbit. So you have two measurements. If you use the same fabric and want to fussy cut the rabbit for the Lower Front Panel you will need 1 yard

Fabric A 1 yd or 3/4

If you use a different fabric entirely you will only need 3/4 yard



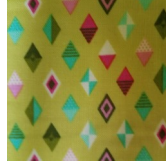

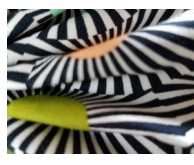

Note. Where it says 1 yard or 32 inches. You cannot buy 32 inches but actually you actually only need 32 inches if you are working from your stash.

Flannel for Pocket Lining

16.5 x 10.5Inches

Decorative Threads I like to use 8 weight threads and I am giving the threads I used as a guide because you can use any.

Dazzle 8 Weight Zinnia

Dazzle 8 Weight Raspberry Wine

YLI Candlelight Turquoise

YLI Candlelight Gold

R- Bosal Double Sided fusible

1 yard of 60 inches wide

Buttons

I used a 1.5 inch diameter `bling` type button on front panel flower (Hobby Lobby) I have not included it in the kit because I frequently find some of the `diamonds` missing on this item. Therefore, I did not want to be involved with supplying you with a faulty item. I prefer to go to the store and directly check their stock and select my own.

4 1 inch buttons to secure flowers to side panel

Trim 1 yard

The trim used in the Flatlock weaving on the Upper Front Panel is also from Hobby Lobby Item # 892539 on a spool color Rainbow

1 yard of 1/8 inch ribbon

28 gauge wire (for flowers)

Medium Weight Fusible Interfacing.

4 strips 20 inches x 2 inches for each of the 4 flowers

2 Strips 3.5 inches x 20 for the larger flower on the front.

Total 7 inches x 20 inches

Cording

1/4 inch cording. You will need 4 times width of fabric which is 5 yards.

Elastic

1 yard of 3/4 inch elastic for side pockets

Feet you will need for this project

Cording foot Lace Applicator and Elastic Foot and a Quilting Guide would be fun but not essen-
