Requirements

- Zundt Design -** Springtime Daisy project book & CD
Bonus Designs 210075 & 210077
- Robison Anton -** Spring Garden – 2551, Palm Leaf – 2241, Salmon – 2299, Flesh – 2413, Bone – 2582
- Stabilizers -** **Weaveline** – 24" (60cm) This is a fine weave fusible interfacing
- Tear away** – Enough for three hoopings in 300 x 200 and eight hoopings in 180 x 130 hoops and one hooping in 200 x 200 hoop. (2 layers)
- Applique Wonder** – 10 ½" x 26"
- Fabrics -** **Cream linen** - 24" (60cm) 55" wide
Pale Green cotton – 10" (25cm)
- Open toe machine foot
Narrow Piping or zipper foot
Tracing paper for printing templates
Software
General sewing and embroidery supplies
2 ½ yds (2.2m) size 00 piping cord
Small sharp curved scissors
Curved safety pins
Frixion pen
Rotary cutter, mat and rulers
Spray Starch

Cutting

Cut the following

Cream Linen

- ❖ Cut the fabric in half widthways giving two 24" x 26" pieces

Pale Green fabric

- ❖ Two ¾" strips WOF for piping
- ❖ Four 5" x 5" squares
- ❖ 5 ½" x 26"

Weaveline

- ❖ 24" x 26"

Preparation

- ❖ Spray starch all fabrics
- ❖ Adhere Applique wonder to the wrong side of the four green squares and the 5½" x 26" strip of green fabric then cut it in half widthways.
- ❖ Press the weaveline to the wrong side of one of the linen rectangles.
- ❖ Use the frixion pen to rule a vertical and horizontal line through the centre of the linen fabric with the weaveline on the back.
